Charles Kesler is the Dengler-Dykema Distinguished Professor of Government at Claremont McKenna College, where from 1989 to 2008 he served as director of the Henry Salvatori Center for the Study of Individual Freedom in the Modern World. He received his A.B., A.M., and Ph.D. from Harvard University. He is editor of the *Claremont Review of Books* and a senior fellow of the Claremont Institute for the Study of Statesmanship and Political Philosophy. His latest book, *I Am the Change: Barack Obama and the Crisis of Liberalism*, received a front-page review in the *New York Times Sunday Book Review*, as well as favorable notices in the *Wall Street Journal* and the *Washington Post*, where George F. Will devoted a column to it. Kesler's edition of *The Federalist Papers*, published as a Signet Classic by Penguin-Putnam, Inc., is the best-selling edition in the country. He has written extensively on political philosophy and American constitutionalism, and is co-editor, with the late William F. Buckley, Jr., of *Keeping the Tablets: Modern American Conservative Thought* (Harper & Row). His articles on contemporary politics have appeared in the *The Wall Street Journal*, *Los Angeles Times*, *National Review*, *The Weekly Standard*, and other journals.
