John F. "Jack" Keane, a 37-year U.S. army veteran, former four-star general, former vice chief of staff of the Army, and currently the Chairman of the Institute for the Study of War.

The Institute for the Study of War (ISW) is a 501(c)(3) organization and produces strictly non-partisan, non-ideological, fact-based research. ISW seeks to promote an informed understanding of war and military affairs through comprehensive, independent, and accessible open-source research and analysis. ISW's research is made available to the general public, military practitioners, policy makers, and members of the media.

ISW's research methodology relies on both primary and secondary sources, enabling researchers to develop a comprehensive understanding of the situation on the ground. In order to analyze military and political developments in any given area, ISW's research analysts must wholly understand the systems of enemy and friendly forces. They must also understand the population demographics, physical terrain, politics, and history of that area. This lays the analytical foundation for understanding the reasons for particular developments and fulfilling their assigned research objectives.

Keane has also penned numerous op-eds and appears frequently on TV news programs to push a more aggressive U.S. military campaign against the militants. "A military campaign is needed to defeat ISIS, not merely stop or contain it," he wrote in a September 2014 *Wall Street Journal* op-ed with <u>AEI</u>'s <u>Danielle Pletka</u>.
