Bradley Foundation Nomination: Dr. Katrina Lantos Swett



Dr. Katrina Lantos Swett Chair, United States Commission on International Religious Freedom President, Lantos Foundation for Human Rights & Justice

As one of America's most prominent human rights advocates, Dr. Katrina Lantos Swett serves as the chair of the United States Commission on International Religious Freedom ("USCIRF"). She also is the president of the Lantos Foundation for Human Rights and Justice ("Foundation"), which she helped establish in 2008.

As chair of USCIRF, she monitors and makes recommendations to the President, Secretary of State and Congress on how to enhance protections for religious freedom or belief. She has traveled and met with leaders from all over the world to defend religious freedom and its role in helping to build tolerant more stable societies.

Recently, she, Robbie George, and colleagues sent a letter to Saudi Arabia. Each offered to receive 100 lashes each in place of Saudi Arabian blogger Raif Badawi. Since their actions, the Saudis have paused their punishment.

As president of the Foundation, she seeks "to strengthen the role of human rights in American foreign policy and to be a vital voice standing up for our nation's most important values of decency, dignity, freedom, and justice in every corner of the world." Her Foundation sponsors congressional fellowships as well as grants and prizes for human rights defenders.

An upcoming event, she helped organized includes Solidarity Sabbath. To confront rising Anti-Semitism, world leaders will show solidarity with their Jewish citizens by attending Jewish Sabbath services on May 22, 2015.

Dr. Swett taught American Foreign Policy at the University of Southern Denmark and is a lecturer on International Relations for Tufts University.
