Peter Berkowitz is the Tad and Dianne Taube Senior Fellow at the Hoover Institution, Stanford University. At Hoover, he chairs the Jean Perkins Task Force on National Security and Law, and previously cochaired the Boyd and Jill Smith Task Force on Virtues of a Free Society.

He studies and writes about, among other things, constitutional government, conservatism and progressivism in the United States, liberal education, national security and law, and Middle East politics. He is the author of *Constitutional Conservatism: Liberty, Self-Government, and Political Moderation; Israel and the Struggle over the International Laws of War; Virtue and the Making of Modern Liberalism;* and *Nietzsche: The Ethics of an Immoralist.* With coeditor Tod Lindberg, he launched Hoover Studies in Politics, Economics, and Society, a series of concise books on leading issues published in cooperation with Rowman and Littlefield.

Berkowitz is the editor of seven collections of essays on political ideas and institutions published by the Hoover Institution: *Renewing the American Constitutional Tradition; Future Challenges in National Security and Law; The Future of American Intelligence; Terrorism, the Laws of War, and the Constitution; Varieties of Conservatism in America; Varieties of Progressivism in America;* and *Never a Matter of Indifference: Sustaining Virtue in a Free Republic.* He has written hundreds of essays, articles, and reviews on a range of subjects for a variety of leading publications, including the *Atlantic, Commentary, National Review,* the *New Republic, Real Clear Politics,* the *Times Literary Supplement,* the *Wall Street Journal,* the *Washington Post,* and the *Weekly Standard.*  **REFERENCES:** Each nomination must be accompanied by two references able to speak on behalf of the nominee's credentials and background, if necessary.
