Gentlemen:

A ruling, addressed to you under your former name of Junior League Blood Center of Milwaukee, holding you exempt from Federal income tax under the provisions of section 101(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1939 (which corresponds to section 501(c)(3) of the Code of 1954), was issued on November 14, 1947.

We have been advised by Earl F. Colborn, Jr., of Fairchild, Foley & Sammond, First Wisconsin National Bank Building, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, that the name of your organization has been changed from Junior League Blood Center of Milwaukee to Milwaukee Blood Center, Inc. A copy of your articles of incorporation, and a copy of the amendment thereto covering your change in name, were forwarded to us by Mr. Colborn.

It is apparent, from an examination of your articles of incorporation and of the above-mentioned amendment thereto, that there have been no changes in the character of your organization or the purposes for which you were formed. Under these conditions, and providing there has been no change in your method of operation, the ruling of November 14, 1947 remains in full force and effect and is applicable under your present name, Milwaukee Blood Center, Inc.

Appropriate action has been taken to insure the listing of your present name in an early issue of the weekly Internal Revenue Bulletin. Such listings are regarded as supplemental to the Cumulative List (of organizations contributions to which are deductible by donors for Federal income tax purposes) which is revised and published periodically.
