Based upon the evidence submitted, it is held that you are exempt from Federal income tax as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as it is shown that you are organized and operated exclusively for the purpose shown above. That return, if required, must be filed after the close of your annual accounting period indicated above.

Contributions made to you are deductible by donors as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers or gifts to or for your use are deductible for Federal estate and gift tax purposes under the provisions of section 2055, 2106 and 2522 of the Code.

You are not liable for the taxes imposed under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes) unless you file a waiver of exemption certificate as provided in such Act. You are not liable for the tax imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act. Inquiries about the waiver of exemption certificate for social security taxes should be addressed to this office.

## OPERATING AUTHORITY & PURPOSE

Pursuant to Section 45.058 of the Wisconsin Statutes and in accordance with agreements between Milwaukee County War Memorial Center, Inc., and the County of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County War Memorial Center, Inc., presently operates the Charles Allis Art Museum, located at 1630 East Royall Place, which was the home of a wealthy Milwaukee industrialist who collected a vast quantity of Museum quality artifacts. The building and its contents were originally donated to the City of Milwaukee in 1946, and operated under the auspices of the Public Library System. In 1979, this priceless community asset was transferred to the War Memorial Corporation, again to be held in the public trust. The exhibits offer a rare insight into exotic art from all over the world. The facility is open free to the public.
