Enclosed for your information and the file are the Restated Articles of Incorporation ("Restated Articles") of Next Act Theatre, Inc. ("Next Act"), formerly Next Generation Theater, Inc. ("NGT"). The Restated Articles combine all prior amendments to the NGT Articles of Incorporation ("NGT Articles"), including an amendment resulting from the effectiveness of the merger ("Merger") of Theatre Tesseract, Inc. ("Tesseract") with and into NGT was the surviving corporation in the Merger. Articles of Merger are also enclosed for your information.

Other than in connection with the Merger, the NGT Articles have not been amended since NGT's final determination letter declaring it exempt from tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code") was issued in October 1987. The only amendments effected since that date relate to the Merger and, other one or two instances of minor typographical errors corrected in the Restated Articles, only affect Article I, the name of the organization.

Tesseract, which ceased its separate corporate existence in the Merger, received its final determination letter declaring to be an organization exempt from tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code on November 15, 1988. Tesseract will file its final tax return on Form 990 as the end of its most recent fiscal year, June 30, 1990, the date the Merger was effective.

Based on information supplied, and assuming your operations will be as stated in your application for recognition of exemption, we have determined you are exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
